

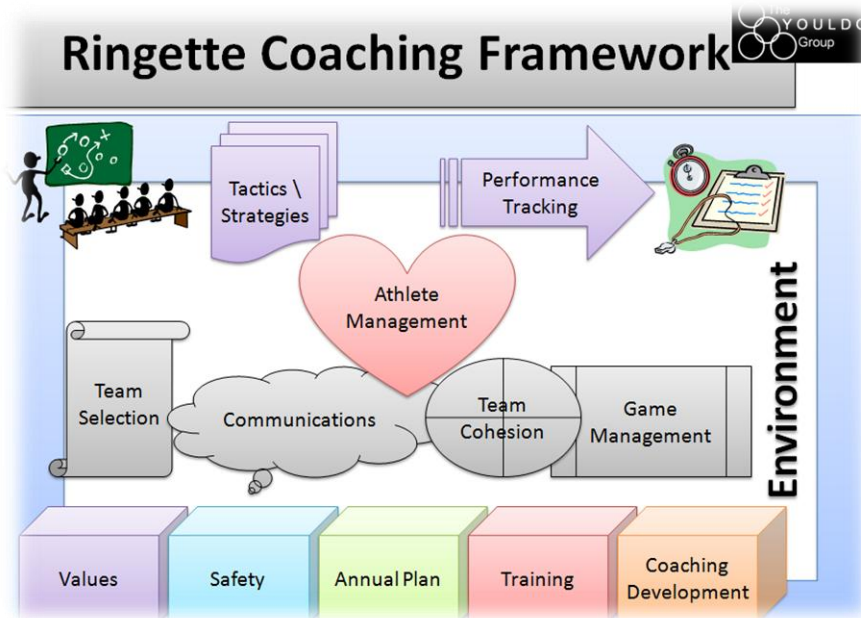
Co Coaching Inventory

Instructions:

- Use this tool to support discussions between the Head Coach and the Assistant coaches on the ringette team.
- At the start of the season, set up a 2 hour meeting away from the arena, players, parents and other distractions.
- Send out this inventory in advance of the meeting so that all coaches can reflect on the questions and be prepared to discuss them together at the meeting.

Key Questions:

1. With respect to the Ringette Coaching Framework below, what does each area or component mean to you as a coach?
2. What role would you like to have with respect to each component (e.g. training, annual plan development)?



3. What is the difference between the Head Coach and an Assistant Coach?
4. For your own coaching development, what do you want to achieve or do this season?

5. What can we do as a coaching staff, together, to help you improve as a coach?
6. How would you handle conflicts between players?
7. How should we handle player problems such as bullying, aggressive body contact penalties and disrespect for the coaches and other players?
8. How would you like to introduce and refine age and caliber appropriate tactics for this team?
9. How would you handle a parent of a player who yells at the coaching staff in the lobby of the arena at the game? How do you think this can be prevented?
10. In a game situation, with less than two minutes remaining on the clock and with our team down by one goal, how should we work together as coaches to ensure a successful outcome?
11. In your view, what tangible, observable results should be achieved with this team this season?
12. What should we do as coaches to ensure team cohesion? Specifically, what can you bring to this team to promote greater team cohesion?
13. What other special skills can you bring to support the success of this team?
